



## Bethel Lutheran School Preschool Dress Code 2009-2010

An important goal of the dress code is to teach children that in the larger arena of life, different types of dress are appropriate for different settings. Parents and guardians who choose to send their child to Bethel accept the judgment of the Administration as final in matters of school policies and procedures, including dress code for a preschool environment. To that end, students in an academic setting are expected to be clean and neat in their personal appearance, observing standards of good taste. It is the parent's responsibility to ensure that the student complies with the dress code on a daily basis while on campus.

Preschool children are required to wear clean clothing in good repair (NO rips, broken zippers, free of holes or exterior patches, messy hems, etc.) that is free from demonic symbols, violent images, and/or inappropriate words or phrases. Children's shoes must be safe non-slipping, closed-toed, and heel strapped. Jellies, oversized boots, platform shoes of any type and high-heeled shoes are not acceptable.
